

FLUSHING WATER HYDRANTS

Due to flushing, it is possible to see an orange tint in your water. The flushing turbulence stirs up fine sands and sediment that our wells produce at very low levels. The Wright Water & Sewer District flushes twice a year, minimizing any noticeable buildup of these materials.

We take pleasure knowing that all our water is chlorinated to kill any dangerous bacteria and microorganisms that could be present.

If you notice any orange tint, run your sinks on cold until the water has cleared up. Usually, it takes 15-30 minutes. Repeat if necessary.
